*You all fit into my grand plan to make a simple scrap quilt the easy way... you do the blocks. It will be a sixteen patch scrap quilt using 19th century (aka 1800s) reproduction style fabrics. A sixteen patch is just four squares by four squares, 16 squares total. I will have very specific information at the February meeting. I plan on having dozens of copies!*

*I will appreciate all the blocks that are made and I plan to work on an old scheme called "piecing on halves". My grandmother was known to do this. Someone supplied her with fabric for two quilts, she made them both and gave one to the person who supplied the fabric and kept the other. I will divide the blocks equally and one of the quilt tops will go to our service projects.*

*Tip for winning the drawing--when there is a very, very easy block like Connie Gresham's make lots. It's like stuffing the ballot box.*

**DONNA BAKER****Day Chapter's January's — Friendship Block Winner !!!**

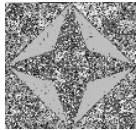
