Quilt Show Entries

We ended up with 235 quilts for the BTQG 2010 quilt show. It should be a wonderful display of all the talent in our guild.

Just a few reminders about entering your quilts:

Quilts must be delivered to Stoney Creek Inn on Friday, November 5th between 7:30 a.m. and 11 a.m.

If your quilt is 36 inches square or less, it will not need a sleeve. All other quilts must have a sleeve in order for us to hang them.

Be sure to attach the label (you either filled it out or printed it when you entered your quilt) to the bottom left corner (right corner when looking at the back of the quilt) to your quilt or quilted item when you submit it so we can easily identify your quilt or item.

Whoever picks up the quilt **MUST** have the claim check in their possession.

Quilts will be available for pickup after the show starting at 6 p.m. on Sunday, November 7th.

Service Projects

A special thanks to all who responded to our emergency call for laundering all the tubs of fabric after some donated fabric that had cat dander on it caused Cecile to have a severe allergic reaction after handling it. Because we intermingled the fabric before we realized the problem, all the fabric in our Service Projects stash had to be laundered.

Due to potential allergic reactions to quilts made with fabric with cat or dog dander, or cigarette smoke (three common allergies) we ask that donated fabric that potentially may carry one of these allergens be laundered before passing it on to us. Use scent-free detergent and no fabric softener, please. Fabric does NOT have to be ironed or folded. Thank you for considering those who will be handling these fabrics in constructing our service projects quilts and/or those who will be the recipients of these quilts.




INTERESTED IN A 221 FEATHERWEIGHT ???
