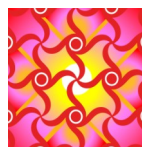

The updated policies will be reviewed by the Board of Directors; once approved, the policies will also be available on our web site and printed in the next member directory.

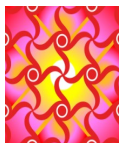
Starlight Exchange Block March Winner — Dennis Smith

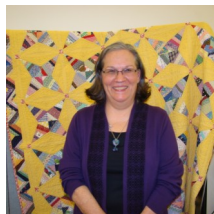
Day Chapter March Exchange Block Winner—Cecile Mazan

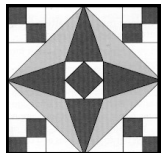

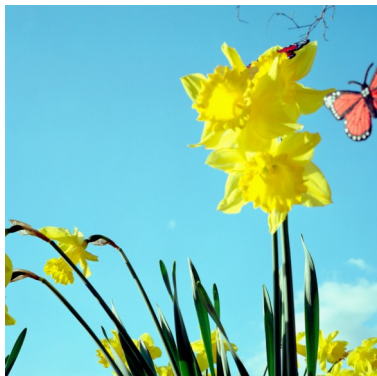

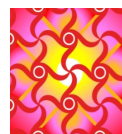
