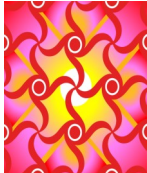

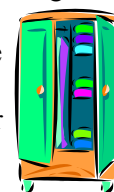
- A-H Desserts**

A big Thank You to all of you ladies who help with the service project work night. All quilts now have labels on them and a lot more 10 minute blocks were made into quilts.

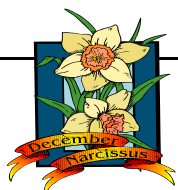
You girls are Amazing!!!

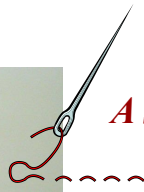

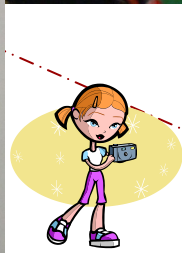
