Lorraine's first book, *Little Lone Star Quilts* is available from C&T Publishing.



No county fair would be complete without a quilt competition. Here is our challenge to you:

Hotpad Quilt Competition.

3 Ribbons to be awarded and prizes to be announced

<u>Rules:</u>

- Entry must function as a hot pad (a hot dish could be placed on it) Materials used must be able to handle oven hot dishes
- Entry may be any shape but cannot exceed 12" in any one direction including binding if applicable.
- Entry must be constructed using any of the following quilting techniques: piecing, appliqué, paper piecing, crazy quilt, and flip n sew.
- Entries may have a single quilt block or multiple quilt blocks as long as overall entry size meets restrictions of rule #2
- Entry may be constructed by hand sewing or sewing machine and must be finished with "some" quilting. (amount depends on method chosen)
- Entry must be turned in with entry form by June Starlight meeting (June 6, 2013, or annual meeting) and will be judged and displayed at the county fair
- Entries will be judged on
 - Adherence to rules
 - Workmanship
 - Creativity
