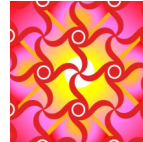


Starlight Piecemakers' Chapter Meeting

Charm group:

We will meet at 11:45 a.m., Monday March. 3. That's just prior to the Day Chapter meeting. Bring your lunch and we can exchange fabric while we share lunch. For the first exchange each participant should bring seven stacks of 10 six- inch squares. Use good quality fabrics, preferably pre-washed. It will take 1/6 yard= 6 inches by the width of the fabric to cut the squares with no waste. Safety pin or thread tack the stacks to make them easier to handle. Pat Yamin – Come Quilt With Me
From Brooklyn, NY

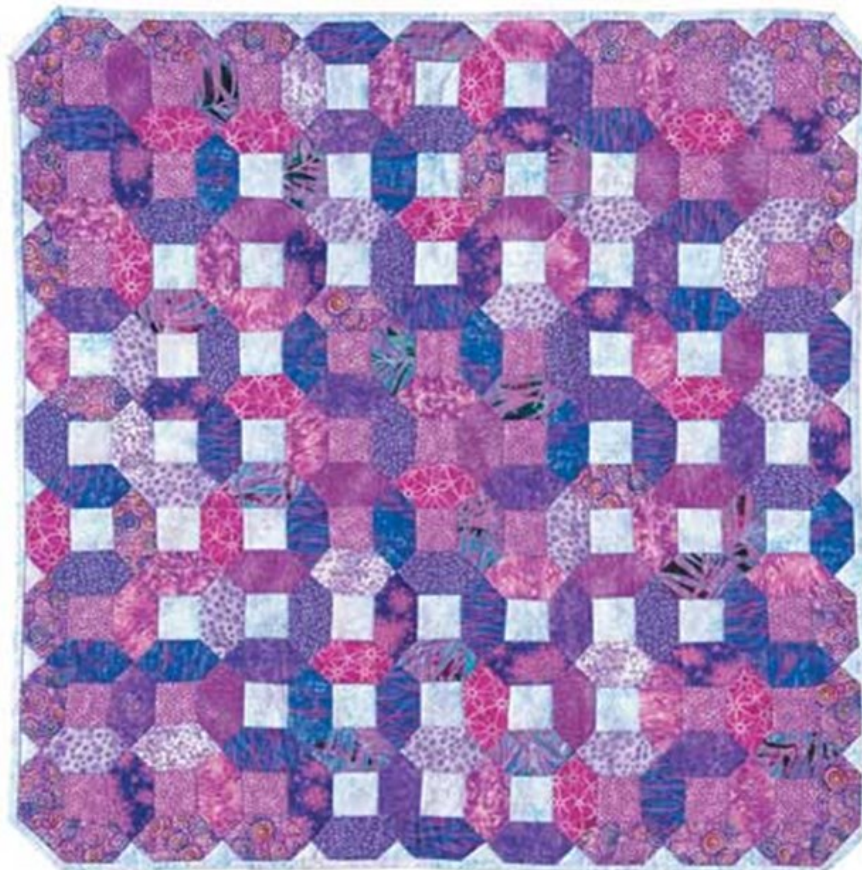
Come Quilt With Me began in 1981, being a mail order catalog for Quilters. You could buy whatever you wanted except fabric through the catalog. Pat had moved to New York from the Midwest. Not being able to find quilting supplies in NYC prompted Pat to buy supplies for her students, and it grew from there. By the late 1980's, the economy was changing and Pat had the desire to manufacture her own products for quilters.

In 1991 she introduced her first line of acrylic templates, PAT'S PERFECT PATCHWORK TEMPLATES, at the Houston Quilt Market. It was so successful that Pat began getting calls from all over, asking her what her next line of patterns were going to be. Her templates have been very successful and many people refer to them as being "goof proof."

Pat will present a lecture on One Patch & Two Patch quilts on Monday, April 7 at the Day Chapter meeting. She will also conduct a morning workshop on her OZARK TILE quilt pattern.

The registration form and supply list for the workshop are on the back of this page. Registration is \$20.00 and must be received by March 19, to ensure we have a minimum (18) number to fill the class. She will take up to 25 students in her class. So if you think you want to participate in the class, please complete your registration **now** and send it in.

OZARK TILE Quilt Workshop – Supply List

- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing Machine or by hand
- 1/4" foot for the machine
- Neutral colored thread
- 28 mm rotary cutter and a new blade
- Mat to cut on, if you have a rotating one bring it
- Sandpaper dots or the Omnigrid non-slip sheets for the back of the templates

Fabric: This is a terrific scrap class. Bring at least 1 yard of assorted scraps and at least 1/2 yard for the center. (This can be scrappy too).

Quilt Show Entry Form – Not Your Mother’s Quilts!

The BTQG quilt show Not Your Mother’s Quilts! will be May 10-11th, 2014 at Fairview United Methodist Church. In order to get the program, map insert, and lay-out done in a timely manner, and accurately, our deadline this year is **April 18th (if mailed April 15th)**. SO... **Start** planning your entries. You must be a paid member to enter a quilt or sponsor a quilt. No quilt may be entered that has been in a BTQG show in the last five years, unless it was voted “Viewer’s Choice” in the previous show.

Again this year, we **STRONGLY ENCOURAGE** you to type your entry directly into the form on the internet. This will make it much easier to do the labels. It also saves the guild money for printing costs. For those who sincerely shudder and shake at the thought of using the internet, we will be happy to accept the hand-written forms. For anyone who is submitting entries by hand, you will also need to fill in your claim check, except the areas marked “to be assigned”. If you do on-line, the computer will fill in the claim check for you. It is quick and easy to do.

TO DO ON-LINE REGISTRATION, you need to know the information from the registration form, especially width and height (IN INCHES).

1. Go to the BTQG website (<http://btqg.missouri.org>) and click on “For Entry Forms Click Here.”
2. On the next page select “Click here” to enter your quilt online.
3. Read the directions at the top, BUT basically you just click on each entry with your mouse and type. **Be sure you pull down the arrow that says type of entry** in order to choose Challenge, Friendship, Wall hanging, Decorative, etc.
4. When finished, hit “Submit Quilt.”
5. Double check your typing for accuracy.
6. If okay, hit “submit my entry.” If not, go back and make corrections.
7. **Print your claim check and label** (all filled out for you) **before proceeding**,
8. Then either click on “Submit another quilt,” or hit the red X in the upper right hand corner to close windows.

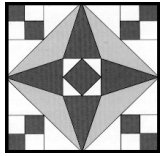
Note: If you choose “wearable” OR “decorative,” identify the item by “decorative type,” so that we can make arrangements to exhibit it properly. Then fill in approximate size. Again, there are categories for “challenge quilt” and “education.” So if you participated in the challenge or made a quilt or other item in a BTQG sponsored class or in a class taught at a retreat, we would like to display those.

If you do not want to use the online entry form to enter your quilt, forms will be available at the March and April meetings. The form can also be printed from the BTQG website.

I will be at the March, April and May meetings to answer any questions. If you already know and have finished some of your entries, please submit the forms early. If you have any questions, you can also call me at 573-445-4217 or email morrisw@missouri.edu.

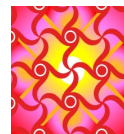
