#### "AND NOW A WORD FROM YOUR CEO"



<u>What is the Cost of Newsletters?</u> Newsletters are essential to an organization. Like everything else, however, they come with a price. In an effort to keep you informed of guild expenses, here is a breakdown of what it currently costs to print and mail our BTQG newsletter to each member. Expense per person each month: paper and printing a newsletter 70 cents, stamp for a newsletter 46 cents, mailing label 3 cents, 3 seals required by post office 2 cents. Total cost for one newsletter to arrive in your

mail box is \$1.21. Cost for the year per person is \$14.52. Last year, approximately 130 newsletters were mailed each month. As of Monday evening, September 9, BTQG has 163 members. Of these, 95 have requested receipt of their newsletter by post office mail. In addition, we print a few extra newsletters to have available at the membership table each month.



<u>Update of BTQG Policies</u>. You will notice revised Policies in your 2013-2014 Membership Directory that will be available at October's chapter meetings. These revised policies are also on our web site, <u>http://btqg.missouri.org</u> for your convenience. The revisions were approved by the Board of Directors at their regular monthly meeting on September 9, 2013. Revisions were necessary to bring the Policies more in line with the By-Law changes that were approved by the guild membership in March 2013, es-

pecially the changes that moved chapter presidents, chapter program chairpersons, the hospitality chairperson, and the membership chairperson into positions on the Board of Directors. If you have questions about any of the policies, please talk to a member of the Board for clarification or for a possible future revision.

Member photos for our Directory. It can be challenging to match names with faces in a group as



large as our guild. Some of our members proposed taking black and white photos of members for the Membership Directory, and the Board approved this project. During chapter meetings over the next several months, Karon Huggler or Laura Eggeman will be asking your permission to take your picture for this project. Being included is optional, of course, and you can forward a preferred head-shot picture to Karon or Laura if you prefer. Pictures will not be posted on our guild web site. For this year, a page

with small pictures will be available in February at the Membership table. The photos taken this year will become the back 2 to 4 pages of the 2014-2015 Membership Directories. Cost for these additional pages for around 200 directories should add less than \$133. The Board hopes that you like this idea and that you will choose to take part in the photo project.

#### September 2014 BTQG's Guest Lecturer and Workshop Instructor

Monique Dillard of Rockford, Illinois, will be BTQG's guest lecturer and workshop instructor in September 2014. On Thursday evening, September 25, Monique will present a trunk show of over 50 quilts to our membership. She will talk about her early interest in quilts and the techniques used in creating each of her quilts. Friday's all day class will give 25 members a hands-on opportunity to begin construction of "Victoria Rose" with Monique showing her techniques and tips along the way. Cost for this 7 hour class is \$35, plus \$8 for the pattern. Saturday morning's class is open to 25 members, and Monique will guide us in construction of a block for the quilt top called "'67 Rambler." Monique will also teach us about color choice decisions and accuracy techniques in block construction, cutting, and pressing. Cost for this 3 hour class is \$20, plus \$8 for the pattern. Use of or purchase of her special rulers for the classes is optional, but they do assist with speed and accuracy during construction. Our BTQG library has 2 of her rulers and a book for check out to members. More details and Monique's supply list for the classes will be given closer to September 2014.

Monique began her experience with handwork and sewing while growing up in the Manitoba area of Canada. Since moving to the States, she has published over 76 quilt patterns and designed 6 cutting rulers. Many of her patterns are fat quarter friendly. She has written several books and been featured in some quilting magazines, including *American Patchwork and Quilting, Quilt Magazine,* and *Quiltmaker*. You can see her beautiful patterns, rulers, and book descriptions on her web site, www.opengatequilts.com and meet her in person during the events from September 25 through 27, 2014.

In an effort to keep you informed of guild expenses, here is a breakdown of guild costs to bring Monique Dillard to you in September 2014. Thursday night lecture fee is \$300. Friday's all day class teaching fee is \$400. Saturday morning's class is \$200. Mileage will be around \$422 and meals around \$62. She has graciously agreed to stay in a member's home, which will save us motel costs of around \$180.
