Starlight Program Windy Wonders: A Quilt Block Grows Up A trunk show by Diane Harris of Stash Bandit

From one humble block comes a whole parade of unique quilt designs. Diane Harris started making Baby Windmills almost 20 years ago and soon realized their potential. She's on a lifelong quest to make every Baby Windmill quilt that lives in her head.

"Windy Wonders" touches on the concepts of value, scale, color and creativity. See how one simple idea can take root, grow, morph and reproduce in exciting ways. Most of the quilts are scrappy so there will be plenty of ideas for making diverse fabrics work together. This trunk show is all about creativity and inspiration.

Diane Harris will be the presenter at Starlight Chapter meeting on Thursday, Feb. 1. The meeting on Zoom will start at 7 p.m. On her website, she writes that she believes having fun and breaking the rules

are more important than perfection or tradition. She also says she never met a fabric she didn't like.



Diane has been quilting 40 years. For 11 years, she was editor of **Quiltmaker** magazine. She then formed **Stash Bandit** to help others make quilts that are both unique and beautiful. Who can take a childhood in rural Canada and turn treadle machine experience into a woman-owned US business that makes a "great big single needle draw with thread all over a quilt?" Susan Smith can! She and her husband (Mr. Producer) have pulled together a very encouraging resource for machine free motion quilting and so much more. Susan is known for turning on a live stream and finishing a quilt in real time (with occasional hiccups along the way to fix) on her long arm. She doesn't stop there. You'll also see her sew blocks, projects, discuss threads or needles and all of it with an encouraging smile! You can currently see her making a quilted coat with some serging, frogging and new techniques. (I've had a Grainline pattern and fabrics for over a year that need finishing so I'm taking notes.) Susan has displayed her quilts at shows and won guild awards. She participates in her quilt guild that has a challenge for finishing vintage blocks (or tops) that is truly amazing! She is going to take us on a "Treasure Hunt" of her experiences.
