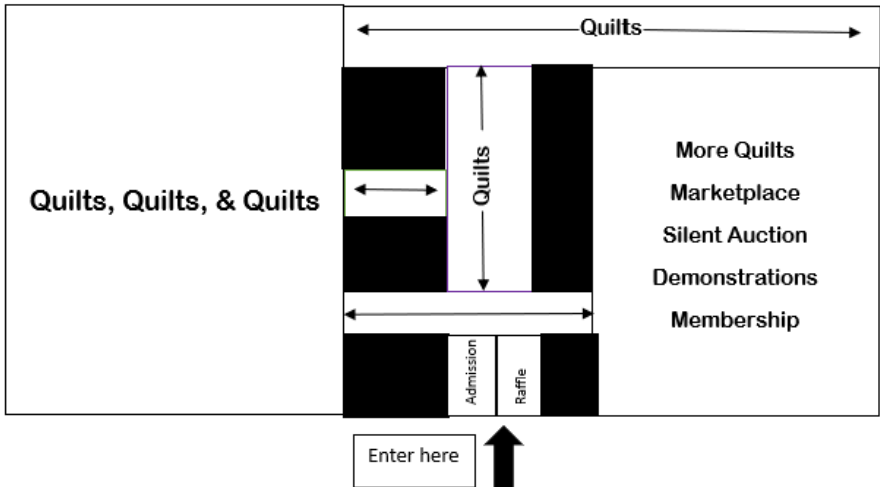

### **2022 Viewer's Choice Quilt Display**

The 2022 Viewer's Choice Quilt in the large category was by Peggy Brothers. This is her description of the project: "Lollypop Trees" was such a fun project. It kept me entertained off and on for four years. I really enjoyed picking out the fabrics for each block. The pattern was designed by Kim McLean and most of the fabrics are by Kaffe Fassett. I hand appliquéd the blocks and machine pieced the quilt. It was hand-quilted by Irene Gingerich. It was completed in 2019. I initially came across the pattern on my new iPad as one of my grandsons was sitting beside me. He said, "I like that quilt, Grandma" and pointed to it. I told him that I did too. When I saw the pattern name was Lollypop Trees I knew I would have to make it!

The 2022 Viewer's Choice Quilt in the small category was by Debbie Odor. This is her description of the project: "Winter Tree" was the second of two quilts I pieced and free motion quilted over the course of a year. A local woman contacted the guild asking if someone would create a 5' x 6' tree quilt to hang on her wall for displaying Christmas ornaments in place of a Christmas tree. A sweet guild friend gave her my name and number. We met in January, and she left a bag full of ombre fabric and the pattern "Alpine Tree" by Mary Lou Hallenbeck of H.D. Designs. The pattern needed to be enlarged 1.75 times to produce the desired size. After deciding I had enough fabric, I got to work. Each piece was machine appliquéd in place. I had never done free motion quilting, but luckily, it was a fun experience. After that quilt was finished by the Thanksgiving deadline, I decided to make this smaller quilt for my mother. She loved quilts all her life and was fond of trees, so it was the perfect Christmas gift for her.

### **“Evening Bloom” quilt**

The pattern is “Evening Bloom” by Blackbird Designs. The blocks were needle-turned appliqued by members of the Sassy Stitchers Interest Group. Those members were: Judy Gieselman, Carrol Lewis, Donna Burris, Betty White, Peggy Brothers, Bettina Having, and Willie Morris. The piecing was done by Willie Morris. The bias binding was cut and pieced by Judi Kirkpatrick. Trina Pratt did the beautiful quilting. Most of the fabrics are French General with a few coordinating fabrics. The quilt was started in June 2023 and completed in November 2023.

### **“Winter Wonderland” quilt**

“Winter Wonderland” by Meg Hawkey of Crabapple Hill Studio, worked in blue, rather than the original red. It was modified to add beading and spacing in the border to enlarge the size. Block embroidery by Martha Eberhard, Nancy Antonio, Betty White, Mona Stevenson, Janice Haralson, Merrill Winfield, Suzanne Henage, Donna Puleo; Feather stitching by Mindy Smith; Quilt assembly by Debbie Odor; Quilting by Lauri Murphy and Corrine Remika; Label by Janice Haralson; Finishing by Betty White – Members of the BTQG Needlework Interest Group.

## **Challenge Quilt Display**

A special grouping of challenge quilts is displayed in our show. BTQG members were challenged to create a small quilt, no less than 12" and no more than 24" on any side, using a focus fabric "Smoke" from Quilted Treasures "Gypsy Soul" series. Participants were challenged to use at least one hand stitching technique in the design, i.e., hand piecing, hand quilting (including big stitch quilting), embroidery, or applique. We hope you enjoy seeing the creativity and diversity in interpretation of our guild members.

## **The Displayed Quilts**

We are pleased so many quilt owners are willing to share their quilts with you. The quilts on display involved many hours of dedicated work to complete and cannot be easily replaced.

- **Why can't I touch the quilts?**

It is tempting to want to touch the quilts; but, even with very clean hands, dirt and oil from fingers can cause damage to the fabric. We encourage a lot of looking but please no touching.

- **Why can't I take food or drinks into the show?**

A simple accident could ruin a quilt. While many are washable, some of the quilts, such as the wall hangings, may not be meant to be washed.
