## **Officer reports:**

<u>Special Programs</u> -- Mavis Mitzel reported for Special Programs. She is looking for committee members and asked for recommendations.

Bettina Havig moved, Louise Bequette second the following motion —The cost for the Marti Michell workshop be adjusted from \$60 to \$50 per workshop. Motion carried.

<u>Annual Meeting</u> -- Martha Eberhard reported that the annual meeting is scheduled for June 4, 2016. She is looking for committee members and has not yet selected a location or meal.

<u>Starlight Piecemakers' Chapter</u> -- Dawn Heese reported that she thinks there are too many chairs set up for chapter meetings and to guest speakers it appears we have a low attendance. She is going to follow up with the church about reducing the number of chairs set up for the meetings. She has received a very good response for people willing to provide rides for those unable to drive. If we know of anyone needing a ride let Dawn know.

### **Committee Reports:**

<u>Day Chapter Programs --</u> Bettina Havig reported she and six members met to schedule programs for the coming year and they are well within budget. A few of their plans are to have mini workshops during a few meetings. They also plan to have spring cleaning in November with tables members can rent for their "spring cleaning" items for sale.

<u>Starlight Piecemakers Programs</u> -- Dawn Heese reported she is looking at several program options, a couple being a UFO exchange and possibly a block of the month. She and Bettina are going to visit on the block of the month to see if there's a way to coordinate that between the two chapters.
