Policy changes passed during May 12, 2014, Board of Director's meeting

In addition to Policy changes passed by the Board at their April 14 meeting, a few more were passed at the May 12 meeting of the Board of Directors. *Additions are in italics*; (deletions are underlined and in parenthesis) **4 Library**

a. Purchase of library materials shall include books, media materials, visual tools and (<u>non-consumable</u>) *nonconsumable* quilting aids.

13 Committee Responsibilities, section titled Chapter Program Chairpersons

Each chapter shall have a Chapter Program Chairperson who shall be responsible for and prepare a calendar of programs for the Membership Directory *and Handbook*

Quilt Show Marketplace

We have the offer of many samples of decorating fabrics to make lovely pillows to sell at the marketplace in our quilt show. We need new pillow forms - sizes 12", 14". 16" and members willing to make one or two each. If you are willing to donate a pillow, we would really appreciate it. Remember, you can enter items in the Marketplace on consignment if you choose, to recoup the cost of materials on items that would sell for over \$10 or more. You can request 70% of the sale price and the guild would receive 30% when the item sells. Hobby Lobby and JoAnn's sell pillow forms. If you get a coupon from either of them, newspaper or e-mail/mailing for 40-50% off, the forms become more reasonable to purchase. We will plan to have kits available at the July day chapter sit and sew or to pick up before or after the meeting.

We are planning other kits to also have available. Of course, you are also encouraged to make items of your own choosing to contribute to our marketplace. Thank you all for whatever way you can help make our quilt show a success in raising money for rent of our meeting space and to have speakers come to present lectures, trunk shows, and workshops for us all to enjoy and to learn more quilting techniques.

Monique Dillard of Rockford, Illinois, will present a lecture and trunk show on Thursday evening, September 25, about her quilting journey. She has many intricate looking quilts, some of which you can see on her web site, <u>www.opengatequilts.com</u>. She will teach a hands -on class on Friday, September 26, with one of her patterns, "Victoria Rose," which has two sizes of flying geese. Her flying geese templates make flying geese accurately, but purchase and use of her templates are optional. On Saturday morning, Monique will teach a class on color choices and accuracy techniques in block construction, cutting, and pressing. Students will also get a good start in making blocks for another beautiful quilt called "67 Rambler" during that half-day class. Look for a sample quilt from some of her patterns at the Annual Meeting on June 7. Registration for classes will begin in August. Be sure to save the dates of September 25, 26, and 27 for Monique Dillard's presentation and her classes. PAGE 4


Marty Webster
