


entries. You must be a paid member to enter a quilt or sponsor a quilt. No quilt may be entered that has been in a BTQG show in the last five years unless it was voted "Viewer's Choice" in the previous show.

Measure your quilt carefully. This is extremely important for the layout design.

Your quilt will need a sleeve if it is more than 24 inches wide.

Due to space limitations at the venue, we may not be able to hang all quilts. Please assign a priority number so we know which quilts are the most important to you.

In the past we have been able to enter our quilts online. We still hope to be able to do that. The online entry form will hopefully be available mid-June. We will let you know as soon as it is ready.

I will be at the June, July, and August meetings to answer any questions. If you already know and have finished some of your entries, please submit the forms early. If you have any questions, you can call or text me at 573-424-1421 or email morrisw@missouri.edu.
