

- ☑ The deadline for entering a quilt is August 24. If you are not using the online entry form, be sure to mail your entry by August 21st. To enter a quilt, go the guild website https://btqg.missouri.org and click on the quilt show 2022 link. You will find links to the downloadable entry form or the online quilt entry form.
- ☑ Please sign up to volunteer to help at the quilt show. Mona will have the sign-up sheets available at the August and September chapter meetings.
- If you will be visiting any quilt shops out of the immediate area, please see Kat about picking up some bookmarks to leave at the shop. The bookmarks are a great way to advertise our show and have the dates, times, and location plus other pertinent information.
- ☑ We have two opportunity quilts. Please purchase a ticket. The tickets are \$1 each or six for \$5.

#### Starlight – Marketplace Workday

Here's another opportunity to make cute items for the quilt show Marketplace. Sewing machines are NOT required for these projects but you will want to bring your normal hand-sewing supplies.

Orphan Critters – These adorable animals will need to be stuffed and sewed shut. We'll provide the kits, but additional stuffing may be appreciated.

**T-Shirt Dog Toys** – T-shirt strips will be provided, but feel free to bring additional strips. T-shirts should be cut into 3" strips. These strips will be braided and knotted to form cute dog toys.

**Wool Mistletoe** – Wool will need to be cut and tied to form mistletoe. Wool will be provided, but additional wool in various greens and reds may be appreciated.
