

A Quilter's Tip From Janice

Have you been cutting fabric with your rotary cutter and it is leaving some of the material connected because the blade has become dull?

If you will tear off a piece of aluminum foil and fold it over so it has one fourth on your cutting mat. Run your blade back and forth through the foil on the mat several times, this will sharpen your blade till you can get a new one to replace the old one. Clean up the cut foil and throw it away and this will save you from having trouble cutting your fabric.
