


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Guild Membership Renewal

Checks received prior to that date will be held and deposited with the first deposit after July 1st. Members who have not paid by August 15 will be dropped from the mailing list. A person may attend two (2) regular meetings as a guest in each fiscal year before requested to join if further attendance is desired.

Dues for NEW members joining after January 1 shall be at one-half the regular rates. A NEW member is defined as a person who has not been a member of BTQG for the past three (3) years.

<u>Consignment items</u> for the Marketplace will return 70% to the seller and 30% to the guild. Consign quilts (new or vintage), quilt tops, kits, equipment (sewing machine, cutting machine, etc.), wall hangings, other sewing/quilting related items. *No fabric, please.* Forms will be available at the annual meeting and on our web site for consignment submissions.

We'll make some at our July Starlight meeting; our goal is at least 50. The log cabin trivet pattern is on our web site under "Fun Stuff".
