CEO's Message

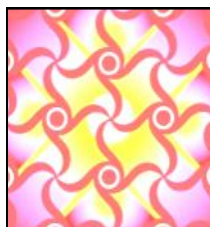


Welcome February! February is cold and still dark, but February is a beautiful reminder that spring is coming very soon! A few updates for you...

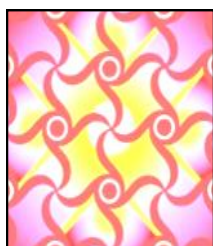

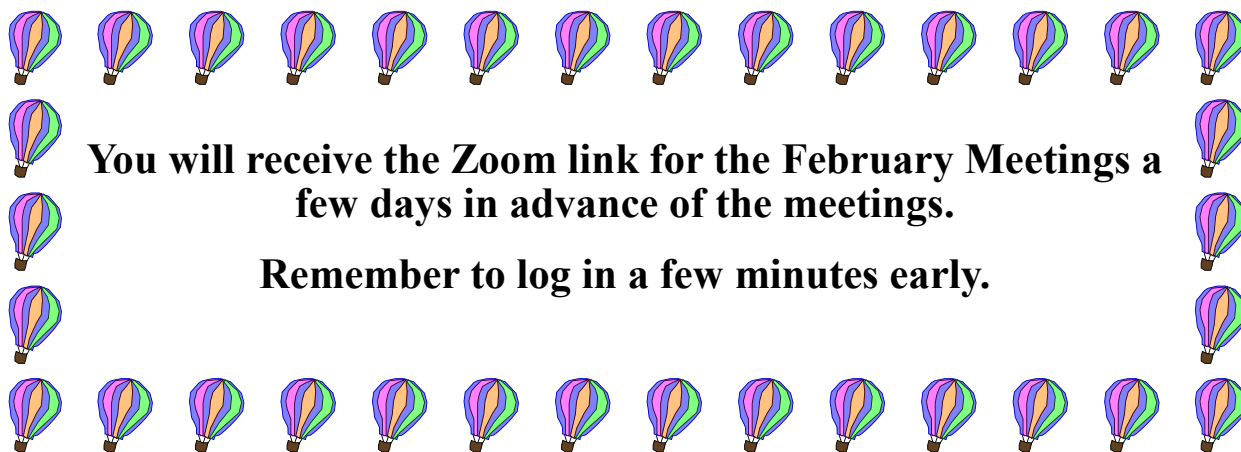
